The Florida Citrus Hall of Fame is located in the Sara D. and L. Kirk McKay, Jr. Archives Center at Florida Southern College in Lakeland, along with the State of Florida Citrus Archives, Florida Southern College's Center for Florida History, the Frank Lloyd Wright Archives and the Florida United Methodist Conference Archives.

A permanent endowment fund supports three student fellowships to work on future Citrus Hall of Fame projects, to catalog and digitize our collections in the Citrus Archives and to maintain the display and web site in perpetuity, thus providing research access via both the school and through our web site: **www.FloridaCitrusHallofFame.com**
